ISF to Host Flag Football State Championship

Ames, IA – The Iowa Sports Foundation will host the 2009 Flag Football State Championship on October 24-25. The tournament will be held on the campus of Iowa State University, in the shadow of Jack Trice Stadium at the Southeast Athletic Complex.

Over the past five years, the Summer Iowa Games flag football tournament has consistently featured over twenty teams and more than three hundred athletes. With the growth and popularity of adult flag football leagues, the Iowa Sports Foundation Flag Football State Championship will feature some of the top adult flag football athletes in the state.

“The ISF is excited to offer this first time event,” commented Iowa Sports Foundation Director of Sports and Operations, Kevin Bourke. “Flag football has continued to be a popular sport in the Summer Iowa Games. We are confident this tournament will produce a true Flag Football State Champion.”

The tournament format is 7 vs. 7 and will be bracketed as a double elimination tournament. Many former collegiate athletes are expected to play. “These athletes make these games fun to watch, as well as exciting plays including multiple forward passes behind the line of scrimmage,” stated Bourke. “The variation of rules makes for a lot of trick plays.”

Teams are encouraged to register early as the tournament will be limited to 32 teams.
